12TH GRADE COURSE SELECTION FORM INSTRUCTIONS

1. Choose English/History Electives

- Students MUST take both a fall and a spring English elective as a graduation requirement.
- ESL students should sign up for English 11.

2. Choose Mathematics Course

- Students must complete one year beyond Algebra II to fulfill the graduation requirement. The options for the year following Algebra II are: Functions and Trigonometry, Precalculus / Trigonometry, or Probability Theory. Students should speak with their current math teacher to determine which is best for them.
- Students who are taking Precalculus/Trigonometry or beyond, or students who wish to take more than one math course must obtain their current teacher's approval and signature.

3. Choose a Science

- Students must take 3 years of science to fulfill graduation requirements.
- Students must list 1st and 2nd choices – these can be either yearlong courses or two semester-long courses.
- If a student wishes to take a course labeled “Advanced”, they must have the teacher's permission and initials.
- Students who wish to take Physics must also enroll in Precalculus or have taken it previously.
- Students who wish to take Green Physics must have completed Algebra II.

4. Choose a Language

- Students MAY sign up for the next level of their language. Students must take at least two years of a language AND complete through level 3 to fulfill graduation requirements.
- Students who have fulfilled their language requirement and do not want to continue to take a language, or students who have a language waiver, must fulfill their credit requirement by taking a *major, year-long* elective in another discipline. All students must have 5 majors each semester.

5. Choose ART and OTHER Electives

- Use the box indicated for either yearlong electives OR semester long electives.
- Students may sign up for a major visual art course ONLY if they completed art foundations OR if they obtained department permission.
- Second choices are imperative. If a student does not make a second choice and has a scheduling conflict, he/she may not receive any electives at all.
- If the student feels it would be helpful, he/she should feel free to write the schedulers a note about what he/she wants so that the schedulers clearly understand what the student wants.

6. Before the form is turned in:

- Obtain all necessary signatures
- **YOU MUST LIST 2ND/3RD CHOICES WHERE INDICATED. IF YOU DO NOT, AND THERE IS A CONFLICT IN YOUR SCHEDULE, YOU MAY HAVE AN INCOMPLETE SCHEDULE, WHICH COULD JEOPARDIZE GRADUATION.**
- Make sure that the courses will FULFILL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:
 - **must take 5 major classes each semester**
 - must have one year of math beyond Algebra II
 - must have at least two years of a language AND have completed through level 3
 - must have 3 years of Science
 - must have four years of English
 - must have 3 years of History
 - must take 1.5 credits of art in one discipline (ie visual or performing) or ½ credit in both disciplines
 - must have 4 years PE unless EXEMPT through sports
- Double check that each course code is written correctly
- Make sure that each section is properly filled out INCLUDING the summer contact information. If there are questions about your form, the schedulers will contact the parent/student in late June.
