FRIENDS SELECT UPPER SCHOOL COURSE SELECTION FORM

9th Grade Course Selection Form Instructions – For students from FSS Middle School

1. Choose Mathematics Course:
 - Students currently in Algebra I and who are earning a C+ or better should take Geometry.
 - If a student would like to sign up for Accelerated Geometry, they **MUST** obtain permission by having their current teacher initial in the space provided.
 - Students currently earning below a C+ in Algebra I, or students who would benefit from another year of Algebra I to form a stronger foundation, should sign up for Algebra I.

2. Choose a Language:
 - Students who have successfully completed 7th and 8th grade level languages should sign up for the *second* level of that language in Upper School.
 - Students who may need a stronger foundation in a language may sign up to take a level one language course. This should be discussed with their current language teacher.
 - Students who have not taken a language in Middle School, or students who wish to switch languages, should sign up for the *first* level of the language.
 - Students who have a language waiver must fulfill their credit requirement by taking a *major, year-long* elective. Choir, Instrumental/drum ensemble, an upper level art (with permission only), or Computer Science would work. You can use the space for “Other Electives” for this purpose.

3. Choose an Art
 - 9th graders **MAY ONLY** sign up for art foundations, Choir, Instrumental Ensemble or Drum Ensemble. Do **NOT** list an upper school major visual art course as these require art foundations as a pre-requisite.
 - Students who obtain permission from the art department may bypass art foundations and sign up for an art major. However, they **MUST** include a 2nd choice, and they should know that it is not guaranteed. Further, the current math teacher must initial the form.

4. Other Elective
 - In rare cases, 9th graders sign up to take an extra elective. These students must obtain the permission and signature of the Upper School Director.

5. Before the form is turned in: **PLEASE HAVE YOUR ADVISOR CHECK**
 - Obtain all necessary signatures
 - Double check that each course code is written correctly
 - Make sure that there are 2nd choices listed for every elective.
 - Make sure that each section is properly filled out **INCLUDING** the summer contact information. If there are questions about your schedule, the schedulers will contact the parent/student in late June.
